What Makes Dr. Dalton's Premium Treats Different?

Discover the difference between high and low quality dog treats and what they do for your dog.

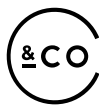
Santa Barbara, CA (November 20, 2017) - While accessing quality protein in dog treats, it's important to remember not all protein is created equal. Dog treats can be divided into high, medium and low grades. Each grade is determined by: the protein source, the percentage of protein of the total treat composition, and the presence of other ingredients in the treat. When choosing a dog treat, keep in mind that high grade treats, composed of premium quality protein, are the better choice for dogs and will aid in keeping them healthy.

High grade treats are composed of around 80% protein, sourced from real animal muscle, and contains few or no other ingredients. Treats made from 100% quality meat are the best option for dogs. Medium grade treats contain about 40% protein this protein is from both meat and plant sources. These medium grade treats may contain fillers such as corn or flour, and often add: sugars, salts, preservatives, food stabilizers, artificial flavorings and colorings. Low grade treats are usually grain based with little to no protein and have similar undesirable additives as medium grade treats.

The best dog treats are created with meat and protein content in mind. It is worth mentioning that quality meat is the most expensive component of treat composition. Because treats are sold by weight, a lot of pressure is placed on treat manufacturers to reduce the quality and quantity of meat in the treat and replace it with a lower cost filler. Unfortunately, the overall quality of the treat frequently reflects dog owner's price preference rather than their health wishes for their dog. Dog treat manufacturers often choose poor quality meat products with fillers such as wheat, corn, or even water to increase the weight of the treats. This may not sound too bad, however, retaining water and adding fillers means that preservatives and binders must also then be added to the treat.

Dr. Dalton has chosen to diverge from pack and create a high grade dog treat that only contains a single ingredient of premium quality meat. In contrast to her competitors, Dr. Dalton gets rid of the excess water, therefore bypassing the need to add preservatives, binders, fillers, salt, sugars, flavoring and colorings. The simple taste and quality of an all-meat treat is enough to keep dogs hooked and their owners happy.

By switching from the typical dog treat to Dr. Dalton's Premium Treats your dog's diet will see a decrease in high caloric fillers and a boost of top quality meat protein. Along with proper exercise, the simple change in diet can produce positive results in dog health and overall wellness. With many diseases, such as diabetes, so closely tied to diet- particularly to high fat and low protein intake, dog owners are becoming more observant of the ingredients in the treats they purchase for their dogs.
